

Prof. Kwok-Hung (Albert) Chung

Dr. Chung is a Professor in Department of Restorative Dentistry, School of Dentistry, University of Washington, Seattle, Washington State, USA. He completed his dental degree (DDS) from National Defense Medical Center, Taiwan in 1979. He received his MS and PhD degrees in Biomaterials from Northwestern University, Chicago, Illinois State in 1987 and finished Advanced Prosthodontics specialist training from University of Texas Health Science Center at San Antonio, Dental School in 2002. He is a Fellow of Academy Dental Materials.

His main research focus are biomechanics of dental implants and implant abutments, ceramic bonding, and manufacturing of dental materials. He has been an active researcher in prosthodontic materials and a reviewer for leading journals. He is author of more than 130 peer-reviewed papers for several prosthodontic-related journals, a "Dental Materials Science" textbook, and book chapters of 3 prosthodontic and implant-related books.
