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Professor Attila Oláh is full professor at the Faculty of Education and Psychology of the Eötvös Loránd University, Budapest. He is leader of the Positive Psychology Research Group of the faculty of Education and Psychology, and he is the leader of the Positive Psychology Modul of the Psychological Doctoral School of the Eötvös Loránd University. Professor Oláh is the President of the Hungarian Psychological Association. His research areas in the positive psychology are flow, social flow, EEG markers of the flow experience; global well-being; psychological immunity; protective factors and positive traits of personality. He published two books in English (about flow, coping and positive traits of personality) four books in Hungarian and 52 articles about his research projects in positive psychology.

As President of the HPA he organised several scientific conferences (with over 400 participants) in Hungary, he was the Local Program Chair of the 6th Biennale Conference of the European Association for Research on Adolescence, he was member of the organising committee of the First International Positive Psychological Summit, Washington 3–6 October, 2002, and he was member of the Scientific Committee of the Third World Congress on Positive Psychology, June 27–30, 2013 Los Angeles.
