

**Márton HERCZEG**

Head of Strategy and Impact Unit

Dr. Márton Herczeg has been Head of Strategy and Impact Unit since 1 January 2018. He became a Programme Officer of the Innovation Communities Unit at the EIT in April 2016 where he managed the partnership between the EIT and EIT RawMaterials until being appointed Head of the newly created Strategy and Impact Unit.

Márton has 15 years of experience advising EU and national policymakers and other decision makers on science and evidence based strategies, initiatives and policies on sustainable management of natural resources, resource efficiency and productivity, eco-innovation and waste management. He also has eight years of experience as a university lecturer in environmental management and economics, environmental performance evaluation and sustainable resource management.

Prior to joining the EIT, Márton was Head of EU and International Consulting with the Copenhagen Resource Institute (CRI) in Denmark, where he led teams involved in strategic planning and solutions for better policy applications for CRI clients, including several European Commission Directorate Generals, the European Environment Agency, the Nordic Council of Ministers and various Danish Ministries for more than eight years. He started his carrier at the Budapest University of Technology and Economics (BME) as researcher and lecturer while also managing projects at the Regional Environmental Center for Central and Eastern Europe (REC), and then at Geologika, based in Budapest, Hungary.

Dr. Herczeg holds an MSc in Bioengineering and a PhD in Engineering Management specialized on Environmental Economics and Management. He is the author and co-author of over 70 publications, including several books, research reports and articles in professional journals.
