

Dr. János KRISTÓF

Dr. János KRISTÓF graduated from the Veszprém University of Chemical Engineering, Veszprém, Hungary in 1974. After joining the staff of the Department of Analytical Chemistry of the University, he became assistant/associate professor, then full professor (from 1998). He was pro-rector between 2001 and 2011, department head between 2003 and 2015, and now is the head of the Chemical Engineering and Materials Science Doctoral School.

His main research interest is the thermoanalytical and spectroscopic studies of thin films, layer-structured materials and organo-clay nanocomplexes.

Currently he is the elected member of 8 national scientific organizations, the Hungarian representative of ICTAC, and the member of the editorial board of JTAC. During the last 15 years he conducted 12 research projects (with total funding of 10,2 million Euro), was the chairman/co-chairman/board member of 12 international conferences and referee of 12 international journals. He presented 195 lectures at scientific conferences, published 183 research papers (with a cumulative impact factor of 256) and has received 2500+ independent citations.
