Giuseppe Lazzara (born 1979) is full professor in Chemistry for environment and cultural heritage at the Department of Physics and Chemistry, University of Palermo, Italy. He received his PhD degree, University of Palermo, Italy, in 2007. He was Postdoc at the Chemistry Department, Lund University (Sweden) in 2009-2010. From September 2022 he is President of European Society on Thermal Analysis and Calorimetry (ESTAC). His research activities focus on nanoparticles and polymer/nanoparticle interactions. He is involved in projects on halloysite clay nanotubes for drug delivery, conservation of cultural heritage, bioplastics and remediation technologies. Further, he was listed by Stanford University as Top 2% of the most cited scientists across various disciplines globally in 2021. He has contributed over 225 Science Citation Indexed journal articles and 3 patents. His citation record is over to 8500 with an H index of 53.
